



SHENANDOAH UNIVERSITY CREATIVE SCHOLARSHIP DAY FACULTY AND STAFF ART SHOW MARCH 22-APRIL 7, 2006

Overview:

All SU faculty and staff are invited to enter the Creative Scholarship Day Faculty and Staff Art Show. This is the second CSD event to feature and celebrate visual art and artists in the SU community. Organized by Geraldine Kiefer, in collaboration with the CSD committee and Smith Library, the CSD Faculty and Staff Art Show will be coordinated and installed by an exhibition committee comprised of Dr. Kiefer's art and art history students. The students will also prepare the exhibition essay/handout and checklist. Space considerations and coherence of the show as a whole will determine how the work will be installed, and how much work can be installed. The show will be on view on the second floor of Smith Library. Sponsored by the library, a reception on March 22 from 5 to 6 p.m. in the Marsh Conference Room will serve as an opening reception. The public is invited to view the exhibition from March 22 through April 7 during regular library hours.

Guidelines and Directions:

All work must be original, completed within the past five years (2001-06), properly framed, and ready for hanging. There is no entry fee. Up to two entries per artist may be submitted. (If space is limited, one work may be returned to the artist and in that event, the CSD art show coordinators will choose which one to install.) Artists wishing to display small three-dimensional works (for example, ceramics, textiles, baskets or small sculptures) should contact Geraldine Kiefer by or before Wednesday, March 1 to discuss tabletop and pedestal display possibilities, then submit the required forms. Works will not be listed for sale.

Prepare your artwork and forms. Print four copies of the form, one for the application, one for your records, and two to identify your work. Fill out two labels for each artwork. Attach one label to the back of each artwork and one to the front. The front tag will be removed and replaced with a card. The artist release form (a separate attachment) must also be printed, filled out and signed. (Artists need not secure the library director's signature before submitting the release.)

Send both forms (hard copies only) by campus mail to *Geraldine Kiefer, Arts & Sciences. Att. Scholarship Day Faculty and Staff Art Show.* Please do not email the forms. Both are due by or before Friday, March 10. No entries will be accepted after March 10.

Deliver all artwork on Monday, March 20, before noon. Art will be received between 9 a.m. and noon at the Circulation Desk of Smith Library. If you cannot deliver your work on that day, please make arrangements to deliver it to the Circulation Desk during spring break. All work must be labeled.

Pick up your work on Friday, April 7 between 5 and 6. Work will be held at the circulation desk.
